## The Impact of Our Choices

When you choose Moore & Giles carbon neutral leather you are helping to offset the cradle to gate embodied carbon impact through third-party verified carbon offsets. “Cradle to gate” embodied carbon indicates the sum of greenhouse gas emissions (GHGs) resulting from the upstream raw material extraction processes from livestock industries such as farming and meat processing, to transportation of the hides (which are diverted byproduct waste from the meat industry), through the completion of manufacturing processes used to convert hides into leather.
